PARENT GROUP FACILITATOR CONSULTANT WITH PART-TIME HOURS

[Literacy Partners](#) is looking for a dynamic Spanish-speaking facilitator to run several Latinx parent groups in New York City. The groups will meet five times each during the period February 2019 to May 2019 with the exact schedule to be determined.

Group participants will be low-income Latinx parents of young children. The goal is to test different facilitation strategies to engage parents in children's early learning and social emotional growth using the Univision-produced mini-series, [La Fuerza de Creer 2](#), as the main content that parents view and discuss.

The facilitation of each group will vary so that we can test different approaches: informal discussion format; parenting support group; and intentional peer learning on specific topics.

The position is for 10-15 hours per week, including initial time for planning for each group along with time to document and assess each group in order to understand how each facilitation strategy works in practice.

About Literacy Partners

We are an adult literacy program with a two-generation approach to education. With our free classes, low income parents – most of whom are immigrants - develop the literacy and language skills they need to succeed in today's world. Our research-based curriculum also incorporates child development and parenting support to help parents boost their children's early learning, social emotional growth, and school readiness. We are expanding our services to include facilitated parent engagement groups using video.
