Program Description	Literacy Partners' adult literacy program helps absolute beginning readers, and readers with gaps in their decoding and encoding skills, to dramatically improve their literacy skills, discover the joy of reading, and have a meaningful opportunity to tell their story. This class uses a two-pronged approach, combining highly structured phonics instruction, fine-tuned to the needs of each student, along with a storytelling curriculum that will help students gain fluency first in oral, and eventually written, language.
Key Responsibilities	<ul> <li>Complete new tutor training (12 hours) - observation of four classes, co-teaching and leading all components of the curriculum (phonics, listening comprehension, and storytelling) at our office at 75 Maiden Lane</li> <li>Make a 12-month commitment to the program.</li> <li>Work with an assigned student one night a week for 3 hours.</li> <li>Show up prepared for classes.</li> <li>Use the scripted phonics lessons and commit to mastery of key strategies for student success.</li> <li>Be trauma informed, collaborative, and committed to student empowerment and creativity</li> <li>Give feedback to the Program Manager to better help group facilitators, group participants, and the program as a whole</li> </ul>
